

4 v 4 VOLLEYBALL RULES

ALL PLAYERS MUST HAVE THEIR UMBC “RED CARD” ID AT EVERY GAME TO PLAY!

Notes: A team can consist of 4 to 6 players. Teams are not permitted to compete with less than four players. In coed play, at least two (2) females must be on the court. If a team only has one female, the team must play with only four (4) players.

Substitutions: Players may enter and leave a contest from any position as often as desired, provided it doesn't give one team an unfair advantage. Ex: One player subbing out when he/she gets to the back row, and subbing back into the front row on the next play. Substitutions must take place only when the ball is dead. Substitutes must report to the official.

Scoring: A match will consist of best 2 of 3 rally scoring games with no cap. The first two games will be played as normal to 25 and the final game will be rally scoring to 15 with teams switching sides at 8. When the ball is played more than once by a team in coed play, one of the contacts must be by a female.

Time outs: Each team is permitted two team time-outs per game. The length of the time-out is 30 seconds. Time-outs must be requested of the official only when the ball is dead. Rest periods between games of the match shall be a maximum of two (2) minutes.

****Intramural Volleyball Rules are based on USA Volleyball Rules. Any situation not covered in the Intramural Volleyball Rules Sheet shall be judged according to Official USA Volleyball Rules****
